We invite you to choose the Union Hospital Health Group (UHHG) Summer Student Nurse Externship as a path to your success. The summer experience will offer you the learning experience in direct patient care environment. UHHG offers an opportunity to become more proficient in your clinical skills and observe first hand how to participate in excellent patient care experiences.

The Summer Student Nurse Externship is offered annually and begins May 26 through July 12 (7 weeks total). Students will be selected to participate in this program. (Enrollment is limited). Upon completion of Externship Program, the Student will be considered for employment as a Nurse Associate II PRN

During the 7 weeks of the Program, you will have the opportunity to work, observe and expand your skills under the direction of nursing professionals.

To Begin Your Path:

To participate in the Summer Student Nurse Externship Program you:

- must be completing your junior year of a four year Baccalaureate Program in nursing, including completion of 2 semesters or 3 quarters of clinical nursing experience.
- meet UHHG job-related health requirements and standards of employment.
- have a satisfactory academic record.
- are current in Basic Life Support at the Health Provider Level from the American Heart Association or American Red Cross.

Application packets must include:

- notification of on-line application completion
- a current official transcript obtained from your Registrar's Office.
- Faculty Clinical Reference; to be completed by your instructor. (This reference is necessary and should be sent directly to us. If it is your faculty's policy to send this reference separate from your application, it is your responsibility to contact Campus Recruiter, Union Hospital, to ensure this reference has been sent/received.)
- Interests/Goals sheet.
- Photo copy of current CPR Healthcare Provider Card
